1. Protected Area Management (PAM)

We integrate protected areas (PAs) into broader ecological landscapes and local development frameworks. Our focus areas include:

- Biodiversity Action Plans aligned with national strategies
- We apply standards such as the IUCN Green List, KfW biodiversity frameworks, and EU Nature Directives for impact assessment and governance.

2. Forest Landscape Restoration (FLR)

- Mainstreaming PES into land-use and policy planning
- Public-private partnership models for environmental finance
